

i The EU Disability Card is optional and available for a fee. The coordinating body in Finland is the Disability Card Office (Vammaiskorttitoimisto) (www.vammaiskortti.fi/en/in-english) together with Kela.

4. Statement of consent

i In order to establish permission to order an EU Disability Card, a statement of consent is needed. Without a statement of consent, the order for a Disability Card cannot be processed. The consent may be revoked at any time by notifying Kela about it.

I hereby give my consent to Kela, the Disability Card Office and the parties administering the card ordering system to process my personal data for the purpose of granting me an EU Disability Card and to exchange information to the effect that I have applied for an EU Disability Card. The contact information stated in the application may be released to the Disability Card Office and the party administering the card ordering system for the purpose of granting and ordering the EU Disability Card. However, information on the grounds for the application for permission to order an EU Disability Card and the contents of the decision may not be released.
